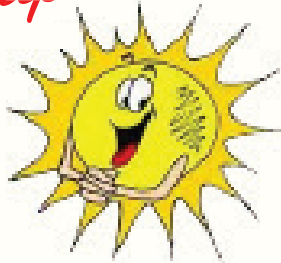
## Summer Tutoring Program

## Summer VolleyBall Camp



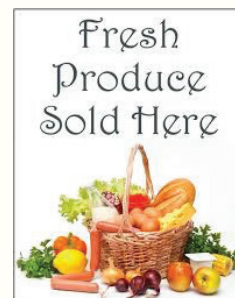

## Looking Forward to 2015-2016

### Rotary Club Grant

The Grants Pass Rotary Club has donated \$1,400.00 to Brighton Academy's Interact club to upgrade some of our playground. This wonderful grant along with some generous donations from our parents will help us begin the first phase of our playground upgrade.

### The Brighton Cafe

Café accounts need to be set up in the front office with a pre-paid \$ amount. We require a minimum of \$50 per student and you will need to replenish the tab monthly. Lunch and snack vouchers can be pre-purchased in the front office. (September menu will be available in August.)

### Volunteer Policy

Brighton Academy believes family involvement is an essential part of a child's education and fund raising participation and volunteer hours are required from all Brighton families. Parents are given a wide variety of choices in which to fulfill their volunteer obligation. Since fund raising is crucial at Brighton, families are required to participate in both our 1st semester raffle and our Jog-a-thon. We ask all parents and students to fulfill the individual fund raising goals set (minimum of \$100 per student in 1st semester raffle ticket sales & minimum of \$100 per student in Jog-a-Thon pledges) as well as attend these events and volunteer in the planning and the execution of these events.

### VOLUNTEER/FUNDRAISING GUIDE LINES

- A minimum of 5 volunteer hours per month per family is required. (or pay \$45 fee)(we will amortize any large number of hours spent on a single event over the school year)
- All Parents/Guardians must attend two "Parents of Brighton Academy" meetings per year.
- Student and Parent participation in all Brighton fund raisers and activities is required.
- Help in the planning and execution of our two annual fund raisers and meet fund raising goals that are set.
- All volunteering must be pre-arranged and documented through the office.

### Tuition Billing

Please remember our tuition is an annual rate billed in 10 monthly courtesy installments, the last installment is billed as June tuition. Tuition is due the 1st of each month with a 10 day grace period, then a \$50 late fee applies.

### Open House

We will be having our annual Open House, it's a great opportunity to come visit with our teachers, tour the campus, sneak a peek at your classrooms, and drop off any school supplies. The front office will be open, this would be a great time to set up café accounts, update registration & immunization forms, and get any other info you may need. Hope to see you there!
