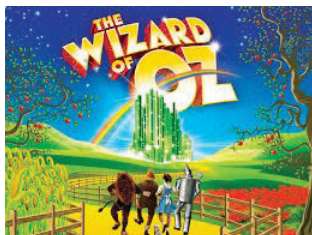

For this to be a success we need all of our families to participate and meet the set goals. Below are the areas we are asking our families to focus on.

Top Priorities:

1. We are asking every Brighton family to bring in 5 -10 addresses of family & friends that we can mail a letter to, asking them to sponsor your student. We have addresses on file from last year, please e-mail or call us for approval to use them. Deadline is April 7th, but the sooner the better!
