## 14th Annual Brighton Jog-A-Thon

The Brighton Jog-A-Thon is our last fundraiser of the year. This year our theme is "Aloha Run 2017." We will have a shopping raffle, a Jog-A-Thon Aloha Fair, a Club Northwest party package, an Emigrant Lake Water Slide Park outing and a cash prize for top earners! For this to be a success we need all of our families to participate and meet the set goals. Below are the areas we are asking our families to focus on.

### Top Priorities:

1. We are asking every Brighton family to bring in 5 -10 addresses of family & friends that we can mail a letter to, asking them to sponsor your student. We have addresses on file from last year, please e-mail or call us for approval to use them. Deadline is April 6th, but the sooner the better!
2. Sign-up to volunteer. We need volunteers for all stages of this event, including our Jog-A-Thon fair. If you would like to volunteer with your student's class booth at the Aloha Fair, contact your teacher directly.
3. We need families/businesses to donate items for each class booth at our Jog-A-Thon fair!
