This year *family participation is required* in our Online Auction, families will have to meet the goals set in

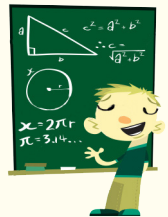
this fundraisers or pay the equivalent fee. This goal can be met by providing addresses, giving donations, raffle ticket sales and making auction purchases.
