Our fall garden is off to a great start! Our goals for the garden this Fall/Winter semester are to start a keyhole garden.

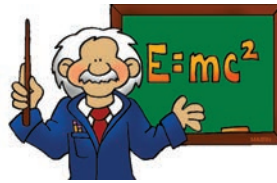
